#### **HEALTH CORNER**

##### **Symptoms of lung disease to watch out for:**

1. Cough is one of the cardinal symptoms of lung disease. It may be acute, meaning under one week or chronic if it goes beyond 4 weeks.
2. Cough may be dry or non-productive. It may be associated with mucus production also called phlegm or sputum.
3. The sputum may be clear as in Asthma or yellow/green as in Pneumonia.
4. Coughing blood-stained sputum or flank blood may be a sign of Pneumonia, TB or even Cancer.

##### **Other symptoms include:**

1. Shortness of breath that may come after a slight exertion or even at rest.
2. Wheezing or noisy breathing is a sign of blocking or narrowing of the airways as in Asthma or COPD.
3. Chest pain especially when made worse by breathing or coughing may be indicative of Pneumonia or diseases of the lining of the lungs.
