HEALTH CORNER

Health Nugget - Retinopathy of Prematurity (ROP)

Did you know that premature babies are at risk of **blindness** from a disease called Retinopathy of Prematurity (ROP)?

Babies born especially before **35 weeks** of pregnancy or have a birth weight of less than **1.8Kg** and who are exposed to **oxygen** while at hospital are at risk of developing ROP. The good news is that blindness is **preventable** as ROP is **treatable** if caught at an early stage during a screening process that needs to be done by an eye doctor who looks into your child's eyes in consultation with the paediatrician before the child is **1 month (4 weeks) old** as the early signs cannot be detected by just looking at the child.
