HEALTH CORNER

Management of Respiratory Diseases

- For upper respiratory tract infections majority are viral.
- Antibiotics often not indicated.
- Treatment is largely to relieve symptoms of sneezing, coughing, fever, muscle pains and headaches
- Plenty of fluids, bed rest for severe illness, light diet.
- For allergic symptoms, antihistamines decongestants and steroid sprays to the nose
- For lower respiratory tract infections, take appropriate antibiotics prescribed after a history, examination and investigations (x-ray, sputum and exam) has been done.
- Avoid over- the- counter antibiotics.
- Diseases of the airways – asthma and COPD require accurate diagnosis and use of appropriate inhalers and other medicines.
- Correct use of inhalers is very important
