THE FRUITFULNESS HAND

Our 2018 annual theme is from John 15:16 and is challenging us to bear lasing fruits. These fruits are found in five Bible verses and can be illustrated by the following fruitfulness hand:-

1. The Thumb (Gal. 5:22-23)

The nine aspects of the Fruits of the Spirit is the first area where lasting fruits are expected. i.e. Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self-control.

2. The Index Finger (Matthew 28:19, Rom. 1:13)

The second area where lasting fruits are expected is in winning souls for Christ. This brings joy to the lost and hope for eternal life. We need to go in obedience to the Great Commission and gather a harvest of souls for God.

3. The Middle Finger

This stands for Worship. Hebrews 13:15 calls this the fruit of our lips. As we worship God in praise, prayer, word, giving, etc we are bearing lasting fruits.

4. The Ring Finger

This stands for social ministry. (Rom. 15:25-28). Paul refers to the gifts that he collected for the poor in Jerusalem as "fruit". Helping the needy amongst us is indeed bearing of lasting fruit.

5. The Small Finger

This represents the works of righteousness. "if I am to go on living in the body, this will mean fruitful labour for me". (Phil. 1:22) Serving people of God in their holistic needs is another way of bearing lasting fruit.

In the last quarter we focused on the weeding of our hearts in order to get quality fruits. I hope we have all searched our hearts and eradicated those weeds.

We now introduce another series in June- September quarter that will focus on the 8 qualities that help us to bear much lasting fruits.

Walk with me in today's sermon as we look at the first quality, i.e. Faith.
