## HEALTH CORNER

### Gastro-oesophageal Reflux Disease (GERD)

GERD results when the lower oesophageal sphincter (valve between the oesophagus and stomach) becomes weak or relaxes when it should not. This causes stomach contents to travel up the oesophagus, triggering heartburn.

Common symptoms include: - Dry, chronic cough, Wheezing, Nausea i.e. feeling like vomiting  
Sore throat, Hoarseness, or laryngitis, Difficult or painful swallowing, Pain in the chest or upper abdomen, Dental erosion and bad breath.  
Treatment may involve lifestyle changes, medications or surgery, depending on the severity of the problem.
