HEALTH CORNER**Breast Cancer**

Breast cancer is one of the most common cancers in women and early detection is extremely crucial for early treatment and survival rates. Breast cancer affects 13% of women in the population.

Breast cancer symptoms that women tend to ignore

- 1) A new breast swelling or increase in the size of an existing swelling
- 2) A cough or coarse throat that refuses to subside
- 3) Changes in the function of the bladder or bowels.
- 4) Fatigue or unexplained feeling of tired which is not associated with any extraneous work. It is also associated with pain and depression.
- 5) Unexplained backache or Back Pain which is difficult to figure out the cause.
- 6) Change in Skin Color over the breast that looks like the Orange Peel ("Peau de Range").
