HEALTH CORNER

Breast Cancer contd.

How can I detect breast disease early?

1. **BREAST SELF EXAMINATIONS:** Research has shown that a regular **Breast Self-Examination (BSE)**, plays an important role in discovering breast cancer, compared to finding a breast lump by chance. A **BSE** should be done once a month, preferably at the same time of day, following a woman's menstrual cycle.
2. **BREAST CANCER SCREENING:** If you are age 45 or older, get your yearly breast cancer screening tests from your health care provider. Ask, discuss and be proactive in finding out more about breast cancer from them.
3. **CLINICAL BREAST EXAMINATION:** A **Clinical Breast Examination (CBE)** is a visual and physical examination of the entire breast, from the collarbone to the bra line, and from the armpit to the breast bone by a qualified health care professional.
4. **MAMMOGRAMS:** Mammograms (a special x-ray to detect lumps in the breast), *save lives by finding breast cancer as early as possible*. Women aged between 45 and 54yrs should have a screening mammogram every year. Women above 55yrs can have one mammogram every 2 years.
